- Jane Timmis Dead Tree (Newland Road) Raised by Jane Timmis, who advised DBC should be contacted regarding removal, with Highways informed if collapse occurs.
   Traveller Site (Flamstead/Markyate A5) Concerns discussed. Jane to provide updates. It was suggested that the Parish Council attend an online meeting with Markyate PC.
